We carry out our activities with taking into account the energy and environmental protection aspects as well, while also optimising the energy costs and improving our energy efficiency to the extent possible, in addition to using our best efforts to increase the ratio of renewable energy resources.

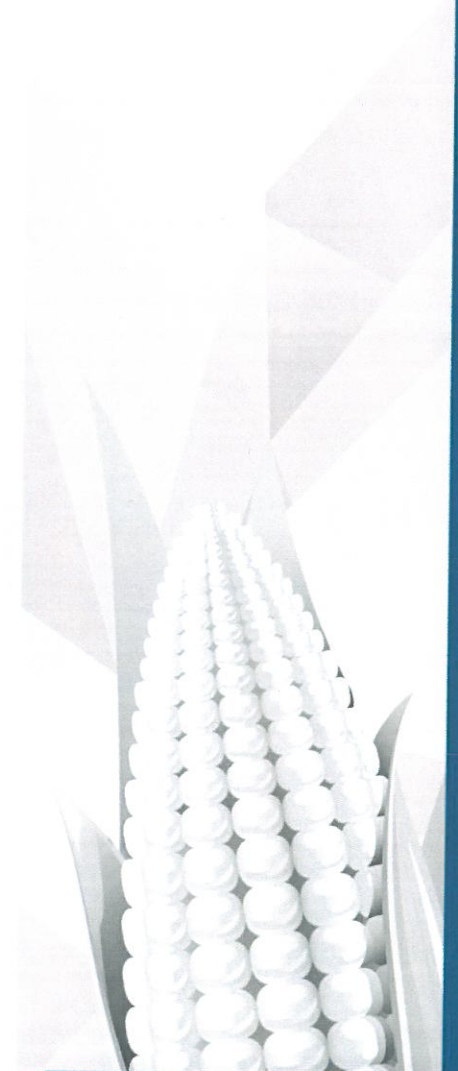
Our company is constantly trying to improve its energy efficiency and energy performance, to which end we take the following actions:

- We identify the areas, technologies and processes crucial for the energy consumption, the ones which are substantial energy consumers and the ones which entail significant energy savings,
- In course of the production of the products manufactured, we plan, design and operate the technology used by taking into consideration the aspects of energy efficiency as well. We support the purchase of energy-efficient products and services.
- We apply the same approach to the continuous renewal of old or obsolete technologies, and also to the purchase of the most state-of-the-art technologies and appliances in course of the introduction of new technologies.
- We are committed to complying with the laws and other regulations related to energy efficiency, energy management and energy consumption, the requirements of other relevant stakeholders, and the requirements undertaken, as well as to continuously monitor the changes in the statutory requirements.
- We develop energy performance indicators in order to reduce the specific energy consumption; we regularly monitor and, if possible, improve such indicators.
- We set objectives and programmes to ourselves through which we can optimise the electric power, natural gas and steam consumption in course of the operation, as well as the fuel consumption of our vehicle fleet. We provide the resources and information necessary to achieve the goals.
- Every year we review the realisation guidelines specified in the energy management policy within the area of application, and we avoid the possible irregularities through remedy measures, thereby realising the continuous development.

We provide special support to the planning and implementation of investments which facilitate improvement in the energy management performance.
